- Ensure employees have access to safe drinking water and adequate sanitation within the workplace.
- Partner with stakeholders to improve community access to safe drinking water.

- Support the collection of post-consumer packaging for recovery.
- Increase the proportion of recycled materials used in primary packaging.

- Efficiently manage production waste by promoting recycling and minimizing landfill disposal.
- Implement best-in-class industry practices and continuously monitor progress against targets.

6. Continuous Improvement

- Regularly review targets and evaluate environmental performance.
- Adjust strategies in alignment with evolving social contexts and the impact of climate change.

7. Fostering an Environmental Culture within the Organization

- Conduct training and activities to engage employees at all levels in environmental stewardship.
- Promote ongoing internal communication to instill a culture of environmental responsibility.
